Sunday 22 January [1919] 100 mins

The sentimental bloke Australia's silent screen era treasure. The tale of a Sydney larrikin who vows to give up his life of gambling and drinking when he falls in love with the beautiful Doreen. Adapted from C.J. Dennis' 1915 poem.

Sunday 29 January [1966] 107 mins

They're a weird mob A comedy of errors of an Italian migrant in Sydney trying to fit in with the "Australian way of life" in the Fifties. Based on John O'Grady's comic novel.

Sunday 5 February [1976] 94 mins

Storm Boy An enchanting coming-of-age story about a boy growing up in the wetlands of the Murray River. Based on Colin Thiele's award winning novel.

Sunday 19 February [1992] 91 mins

The Silver Brumby A tale of unforgiving wilderness, the obsession of a man, and the beauty of a stallion. Based on Elyne Mitchell's popular story.

Sunday 26 February [2000] 75 mins

The Magic Pudding The delightful, true blue, magical adventures of Bunyip Bluegum and his friends Bill Barnacle and Sam Sawnoff. Adapted from Norman Lindsay's best known children's book.
